



This map shows the route of the evacuation of Anders' Army from the Soviet Union along the Trans Caspian Railway Line in 1942

A: Starting point was Jangijul (now Yangiyol), Uzbekistan, south of Tashkent, the headquarters of the Anders' Army

B: Samarkand

C: Kermine (now Navoiy) where Polish Air Force was mustered

D: Bukhara

E: Turkmenabat

F: Merv (now Mary)

G: Tejen

H: Ashgabat

I: Krasnovodsk (now Turkmanbashi), from where the Army was shipped to Pahlevi, Persia (now Bandar-e Anzali, Iran)

The journey on the Trans Caspian Railway was about 1,800kms
